NOTICE OF RACE

Event: 2010 Fall BOARDBOAT SERIES

Dates: 12 September 2010, 10 October 2010, 14 November 2010

Host: Lake Canyon Yacht Club, Canyon Lake, Texas

Eligibility: The series is open to all centerboard/boardboat classes.

Racing Rules: This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012, as modified for 2010-2012, the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association (USSA), this Notice (except as any of these are modified by the sailing instruction), the current version of the Canyon Lake sailing instructions, and if sailing in a one design fleet, the applicable class rules. This event is classified as a category "A" event. Any additional information will be posted on the official notice window of the clubhouse.

Registration: Only boats with paid registrations and entries registered online shall race. You may register online from home or from the clubhouse computer for the series race, prior to the end of late registration, or for any single race on the day of the race, prior to the RC leaving the dock. You must race in the class that you register for throughout the series.

Youth Sailors: All sailors 18 and under must provide a signed parental approval and release. Forms are available on the LCYC web site and can also be signed on the day of the race.

Scoring: Low point system as outlined in Appendix A2.2 and A5, i.e., 1st place = 1, 2nd = 2, 3rd = 3, 4th = 4, etc. Single day racers will not be scored in the series results, but their actual finishing positions will be recognized in the race report.

Proposed Classes: Sunfish, Sunfish Juniors, Laser, Flying Scot, Portsmouth Boardboat, Portsmouth Multihull (catamaran), and Optimist. Three (3) boats of a class or similar Portsmouth rating may constitute a fleet. Actual fleets will be set and announced at the Skippers' Meeting. No fleets will be formed after the Skippers' Meeting. Size of fleet for determining number of trophies will be based upon number of paid registrations as of 14 March 2010.

Races and Courses: Three scheduled (3) races each Sunday for a total of nine (9) races. The best six (6) of the total races, counted from the last race to the first, for each boat will determine final standing. The course for each race will be posted on the stern of the committee boat before each race. The course for each race shall be at the discretion of the Race Committee.

Trophies: 3 to 4 boats = 2 trophy; 5 to 7 = 3; 8 to 9 = 4; 10 to 13 = 5; 14 to 16 = 6; 17 to 19 = 7; 20 and over = 8.

Refreshments: Beer, soda & snacks, 12 September and 10 October
Dinner – 14 November 2010 - trophies to follow.
