2012 WINTER BOARDBOAT SERIES

NOTICE OF RACE

Event: 2012 WINTER BOARDBOAT SERIES

Dates: 11 December 2011, 15 January 2012, 12 February 2012

Host: Lake Canyon Yacht Club, Canyon Lake, Texas

Eligibility: The series is open to all centerboard/boardboat and catamaran classes.

Racing Rules: This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012, as modified for 2010-2012, the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association (USSA), this Notice (except as any of these are modified by the sailing instruction), the current version of the Canyon Lake sailing instructions, and if sailing in a one design fleet, the applicable class rules. This event is classified as a category "A" event. Any additional information will be posted on the official notice window of the clubhouse.

Registration: Only boats with paid registrations and entries registered online shall race. You may register online from home or from the clubhouse computer for the series race, prior to the end of late registration for the series, or for any single race, prior to close of late registration for single day racing . You must race in the class that you register for throughout the series.

Youth Sailors: All sailors 18 and under must provide a signed parental approval and release, which includes a release that allows LCYC to use photos of participants. The waiver and release for participants and parents is included in the on line registration form.

Scoring: Low point system as outlined in Appendix A2.2 and A5, i.e., 1st place = 1, 2nd = 2, 3rd = 3, 4th = 4, etc. Single day racers will not be scored in the series results, but their actual finishing positions will be recognized in the race report.

Proposed Classes: Sunfish, Sunfish Women, Sunfish Juniors, Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Flying Scot, Portsmouth dinghy, Portsmouth catamarans, and Optimist. Three (3) boats of a class or similar Portsmouth rating may constitute a fleet. Actual fleets will be set and announced at the Skippers' Meeting. No fleets will be formed after the Skippers' Meeting. Size of fleet for determining number of trophies will be based upon number of participants as of the close of series registration.

Races and Courses: Three scheduled (3) races each Sunday for a total of nine (9) races. The best six (6) races for each boat will determine final standing. A minimum of one race shall constitute the series. The course for each race will be posted on the stern of the committee boat before each race. The course for each race shall be at the discretion of the Race Committee.

Trophies: 3 to 4 boats = 2 trophy; 5 to 6 = 3; 7 to 8 = 4; 9 to 11 = 5; 12 to 15 = 6; 16 to 19 = 7; 20 and over = 8.

Refreshments: Beer, soda & snacks, following racing on 11 December and 15 January.
Dinner 12 February - trophies to follow.
